Instructions for Posting a Public Notice

Before your application can be reviewed by the local EMS District Board, a public notice stating your licensure intentions must be printed in the local newspaper of general circulation for the intended service area. The applicant should contact the EMS District Board as early as possible to schedule a meeting after the deadline for public comments.

The public comment period should be set at least 14 days from the date the notice is published.

The Department of Health will forward all comments to the applicant and the local District Board. The District Board with then review the application, any comments received, and forward a recommendation regarding licensure to the Department.
