 - Consideration of Licensee Request for Finding of Unreasonable Hardship with Regard to Tax Status under 32 V.S.A. § 3113(g)(4). A podiatrist who is unable to certify good standing with regard to taxes owed to the State of Vermont for the current renewal of podiatry licenses has submitted a request for the Board to find that requiring immediate payment of taxes due and payable would impose an unreasonable hardship on him. 32 V.S.A. § 3113(b) prohibits issuance of a license or renewal unless the licensee certifies that they are in good standing with respect to taxes. However, 32 V.S.A. § 3113(g)(4) allows an agency (including a board) to issue a renewal on terms designed to get the licensee to achieve good standing quickly:

(4) in the case of a licensee, the agency finds that requiring immediate payment of taxes due and payable would impose an unreasonable hardship. If the agency finds an unreasonable hardship, it may condition renewal on terms that will place the person in good standing with respect to any and all taxes as soon as reasonably possible.

The request and other materials submitted by the licensee will be considered and the Board will be asked to determine if relief should be granted in response to the request.
