
## Vermont's Population is Growing Older

One in three Orleans County residents are over the age of 60 (31% or 8,600 adults), making it the 8th oldest population in the state. Since 2001, Orleans County has experienced a decreasing youth and a growing older adult population. An increasing older adult population creates new challenges and emerging health risks.

## **Removing Barriers to Support Healthy Aging**

Age Strong VT is working to make sure all Vermonters can age well. There are health differences between age decades in Orleans County which should be considered

support they need.

when planning institutional support for all older adults. The proportion of older adults living alone increases among adults 80 years and older. Older adults who live alone are at higher risk for loneliness, injury from falls, and cognitive decline. Approximately 20% of adults 70 years and older do not receive the social and emotional support they need. About one-third of all older adults fell in the past year. Experiencing cognitive decline increases slightly from 60-69 to 70-79 while not seeing a healthcare provider or drinking alcohol at a risk level decreases with age.
