


# High School Students Who Vape at Higher Rates Than the Statewide Rate (2021 YRBS)

Students who smoke cigarettes, tried flavored tobacco before age 13, binge drink or use cannabis vape at the highest rates.

**Graph Interpretation:** Gray bar shows the VT estimate. Colored bars show vaping prevalence within each sub-population. *E.g.*, 91% of youth who currently smoke cigarettes also currently vape while 25% of students with poor mental health currently vape.



<u>Graph Interpretation</u>: Gray bar shows the VT estimate. Colored bars show smoking prevalence within each sub-population. *E.g.*, 36% of youth who tried flavored tobacco before age 13 currently smoke cigarettes while 10% of students with a disability currently smoke cigarettes.

**Concurrent Substance Use and Initiation** 

### **Data Notes:**

- **Vaping** refers to electronic vapor products used in the past 30 days including: e-cigarettes, vapes, vape pens, e-cigars, e-hookahs, hookah pens & mods.
- Cigarette and Cannabis Use are in the past 30 days.
- Binge Drinking = five or more drinks on an occasion (men), four or more for women in the past 30 days.
- Subjective Social Status is a proxy measure for socioeconomic status.
- **Poor Mental Health** includes stress, anxiety and depression, and youth who felt their mental health was not good at least most of the time in the past 30 days.
- Disability includes those with a long-term health problem.
- IEP or 504 Plan = Individualized Education Plan or supports and services for students with disabilities.
- BIPOC = Black, Indigenous and people of color.
- Older Students = those in 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grades.
- **LGBTQ+** = Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and other sexual orientations, or those questioning or unsure of their sexual orientation or gender identity.
