## Why are we doing this?











Fulfill SAMHSA grant reporting requirements

More accurately measure people served

Improve responses to media and stakeholders

Collect consistent data that's easier to aggregate

Measure the impact of services



Expect the following standard fields to be included in grant reporting surveys:

- Grant number (required number format to ensure valid entry)
- Valid calendar dates:
  - Reporting period start date
  - Reporting period end date
- Program/service type
- Cumulative number of unique (i.e., unduplicated) individuals served

## Cumulative is the number of <u>unique</u> (i.e., unduplicated) people served

Q1

• 100 people served

Cumulative = 100 Unique People Q2

- 110 people served
- 90 were also served in Q1
- 20 are new in Q2
- Cumulative = 100+20 = 120 unique people

Q3

- 80 people served
- 70 were served in Q1 or Q2
- 10 are new
- Cumulative = 120+10=130 unique people

Q4

- 120 people served
- 110 were served in Q1, Q2, Q3
- 10 are new
- Cumulative = 130+10=140 unique people

Cumulative is <u>not</u> the same as the total served each quarter!

In this example, total served overall is 100+110+80+120= 410

While cumulative people served = 140 unique people
