Be Ready!

To receive immunization histories from the IMR, you must be able to receive and display *all* CVX codes. For an updated list, visit: cdc.gov/vaccines/programs/iis/code-sets.html

Be Aware!

The IMR is linked with Vital Records; if a patient is born in Vermont, we will have the name on the birth certificate. We do update names after adoptions (monthly) and marriages (annually).

Be Prepared!

Vaccine events are recorded by our first-in policy: and cannot be updated or changed from an HL7 sender once entered into the IMR.

For example, if a Hep B NOS (unspecified) is entered by a pharmacy, their primary care provider will be unable to add updated information to the record through HL7.
