### **Eligibility Requirements:**

To qualify for WIC, people must meet the following requirements:

Fit into one of the following categories:

- A pregnant person
- A person who was pregnant in the last 6 months
- A breastfeeding/chestfeeding person with an infant up to 12 months old
- An infant or child up to 5 years old (applied for by parent or caregiver)
- Be a resident of Vermont

Meet income guidelines or participate in 3SquaresVT (SNAP), Medicaid, TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) or Families with Dependent Children program.
