

Liability and Worker's Compensation Protections for Volunteers

January 2020

Qualified volunteers receive the same liability protections and workers' compensation coverage as state employees when they are training for or responding to a public health event or emergency. To be qualified for these protections, volunteers must serve at the request of and under the direction and control of a state agency, such as the Department of Health. Volunteers may not receive hourly or salary compensation from a state agency. Vermont law also provides certain liability protections for qualified partnerships, associations and businesses engaged in emergency management activities. The full text of these laws includes additional information about eligibility and the extent of the coverage and is available online as indicated below.
